All changes and cancellations must be received in writing prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club. **Entries are limited to 100 in each Show.**

Entries must be sent "no signature required". The Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for entries that are delivered late because of signature requirements.

Faxed Entries will be accepted at **(818) 909-4643** for a fee of \$2.00 added, per entry. **Fax both the front and back of entry form** completely filled out and signed. **Also a copy of your check for payment of entry fees.** Actual check and form must be received within three days after close of entries. **Include the \$2.00 fax charge per entry.**

Entries - Entries not on an official AKC entry form are not acceptable and photocopies of the entry form must have the Agreement and Instructions on the reverse side. Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, whoever may make such errors. Entry fees will not be refunded in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, duplicate entries, nor in the event that a dog is absent, a bitch in season, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by the Show Committee. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The show secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. The returned check must be made good by cash or money order before the dog will be allowed in the ring. If, because of extreme weather conditions, dots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee(s) will be made.

Declination of Entries - COAST may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against COAST or any official thereof.

Entry Acknowledgement - If an exhibitor's confirmation and judging program are not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the Show Secretary at (818) 909-4643. Consult the judging program for time of judging. If it is desired that an agent receive a judging program and copy of exhibitor's confirmation, include name and address with request.

Change of Entries - **1:** A correction may be made in the sex of a dog, or a dog may be transferred from one division of the Puppy Class to another or between the Puppy and Twelve-to-Eighteen Month Class at a show prior to the judging. **2:** A dog determined to be ineligible, by its owner/agent, for the class in which it has been entered may be transferred to an eligible open class at a show prior to the judging of any regular conformation class within the sex of that breed or variety. **3:** Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for a show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

No dog may otherwise be transferred to another class.

Observers - As part of the AKC approved observer program for educating judges, a judge who contemplates applying for additional breeds may, with prior approval, observe in the ring while regular judging is in progress.

Judging - The judging will start promptly. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their time of judging, and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging. The club and its show secretary will not be responsible and are not obligated to notify exhibitors or their agents of class judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Judges will not hold up a class by waiting for any dog.

Trophies - Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging rings to the person exhibiting the dog, who will be considered to be the owner or agent of the owner. All claims for trophies and other prizes must be made in the judging ring before the completion of show and the show chairman must be advised at once in the event of any discrepancy. No award will be mailed.

Loss or Damage - The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs, exhibitors and spectators, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or spectators participating in this show. By entering this show the owner, exhibitor or handler agrees to hold harmless and indemnify the City of Angels Silky Terrier Club, Inc., its members, officers and board of directors against claims or damages arising out of the conduct of any exhibitor and/or their dog or dogs. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles.

Set-ups & Grooming - No grooming tables, pens or exhibitor set-ups will be allowed in the aisles, and all grooming must be done away from the judging ring in areas specified by the Club.

Health of Dogs - Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Unentered Dogs - There are no provisions for unentered dogs at this show. Absolutely no puppies under the age of six months will be permitted within the show limits.

Clean-up - Each and every exhibitor and dog owner is responsible for cleaning up after his own dog. There will be no clean-up committee. Any violators will be subject to discipline by the Show Committee.

Day of Show Parking: Parking is \$9 payable to Fairplex upon arrival, motor homes will cost more.

Entrance will be Gate 17. Gates open at 6:00AM Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

Unloading/Loading Lights will be left on and key in vehicle in the loading area. Any vehicles unattended or in violation of parking policy will be towed

Reserved Overnight Parking

Overnight parking is available at \$35 per night with no electrical hookups and \$55 per night with electrical hookup. Electrical hook ups limited to 70 vehicles. Spaces are approx. 22 feet wide. All vehicles must be self-contained. A self addressed, stamped envelope must be sent with each reservation. Confirmation will be sent. This confirmation will allow you to enter the grounds on Thursday or Friday between 2-10 PM F Gate will also be open Fri. Sat. and Sun. from 6-7 AM Make your check payable to Antelope Valley KC. Additional Parking regulations

- All parking will be on asphalt. Bring appropriate ground cover.
- Each parking space is for one vehicle only. (Trailer and tow vehicle are considered as one vehicle.) You may purchase a Tag Vehicle permit for \$5.00 per night. All vehicles MUST be parked inside the lines of your assigned space.
- If you wish to park together you MUST send your reservation forms in one envelope. No separate requests.
- Your area must be left clean when leaving Fairplex.
- Any vehicles parking illegally (aisles, fire lanes, no parking areas etc.) will be towed at the owners expense.
- Any unnecessary arguing or abusive language to members of the parking crew and you will forfeit all parking privileges for the rest of the circuit. There will be no refunds, and you could suffer the possibility of discipline by the Bench Show Committee.
- There is a waste-dump station located by the bathroom in the picnic hill area.
- No electrical cords can run across any roadways or fire lanes.
- Handicap parking may not be close to the rings but will have easy ring accessibility. You need to send a copy of your handicapped license with your name on it. (No copies of placards will be accepted.)
- If your check is returned and not cleared up within a three-month period, you may be denied future entries and parking.

Any damage caused to power supplied by Fairplex is the sole responsibility of the person whose vehicle caused that damage while plugged into that power. These damages must be paid for at the time of the damage.

Bred by Exhibitor Class Eligibility: 1) All dogs entered in the Bred by Exhibitor class must be individually registered with the AKC, 2) the person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog, and 3) family members must be both a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in this class.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Veteran Dogs -- For dogs over 7 years of age
Veteran Bitches -- For bitches over 7 years of age

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

BEST OF BREED -- Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a Championship, but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the Championship of the dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed Competition are to be made until its Championship has been confirmed by the A.K.C.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE ENTRIES (AM Show only)

STUD DOG CLASS -- For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this Show or Trial. The award will be based on the merits of the two get, get only to be judged. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in this class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed Competition by virtue of having won this class. The Stud Dog must appear in the ring with his two get and be entered in the Stud Dog Class.

BROOD BITCH CLASS -- For Bitches that have whelped two dogs or bitches entered in this Show or Trial. The award will be based on the merits of the two produce. produce only to be judged. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in this class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed Competition by virtue of having won this class. The Brood Bitch must appear in the ring with her two produce and be entered in the Brood Bitch Class.

BRACE CLASS -- For two dogs or bitches of the same breed with identical ownership.

TITLE PARADE

Dogs that are AKC Champions or Obedience Title holders may be entered for the Title Parade only. Dogs so entered will be presented with a Rosette with the dog's name printed on the streamer. The dog's name and the owner's name will be announced at the time of presentation of the Rosette.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Novice Class: This shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Class: This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class in a licensed or member show, with competition present. The winner of a Novice Class shall automatically become eligible, upon notice to the Open Class ring steward, to enter and compete in the Open Class at the same show provided the win is the third (3rd) first place award with competition and further providing there are one or more Junior Handlers competing in the Open Class.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any Junior Showmanship class at the show.

Junior, Intermediate and Senior Classes. Each of the regular classes are divided by age into Junior, Intermediate and Senior Classes. A Junior Class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show. The Intermediate Class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show. The Senior Class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

Best Junior Handler. The Junior Handler placed first in each of the regular Junior Showmanship Classes, if undefeated in any other Junior Showmanship Class at that show, shall automatically be eligible to compete for this prize.

Each dog handled in a Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the Breed or Obedience Classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitutions must be made one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show. Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather or grandmother, including step and half relations or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or in Obedience Trials. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a Breed Judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused by the Veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship.

Winning of first place in an Open Class at this show may qualify or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes. For information on eligibility requirements for limited Junior Showmanship Classes which have been approved to date by AKC, write to the American Kennel Club, Show Plans, 51 Madison Avenue, New York, New York 10010.

An individual listed as an agent is not eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship, nor any person who distributes rate cards or otherwise advertises themselves as handling dogs for pay in the show ring, or accepts payment for handling dogs. Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler identification number on the entry blank. You may obtain your number by calling the AKC Event Records Department (919) 816-3776. **Notice: Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.**

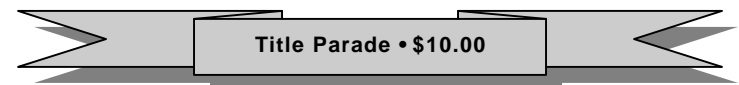
